

## IMPROVISATION SHEET #2

### THE FIVE MINOR PENTATONIC SCALE SHAPES

There are five **minor pentatonic scale shapes** that you should know. They are *moveable*. The root (**G**) identifies the name of the scale.

### THE FIVE G MINOR PENTATONIC SCALE SHAPES

The following diagrams illustrate the five minor pentatonic scale shapes for the **G minor pentatonic scale**. Play each scale from the lowest sounding root, play up to the highest note, down to the lowest note and then return to the lowest root. Experiment with moving from one scale shape to another. Use the *slide* technique to move from one shape to another.
